

Tickets are fifteen dollars and are on sale now! Children 4-18 are four dollars, and children under four are free!


### **VOLUNTEER WITH US!**

Performances must be family-friendly and meet the purpose and mission of the International Festival: To showcase and provide educational opportunities about the diverse cultures within our community, while promoting tourism and generating a positive impact on our local economy. This competition is open to students K-12 and adults of all skill levels. The deadline for art is Monday, May 29th.
